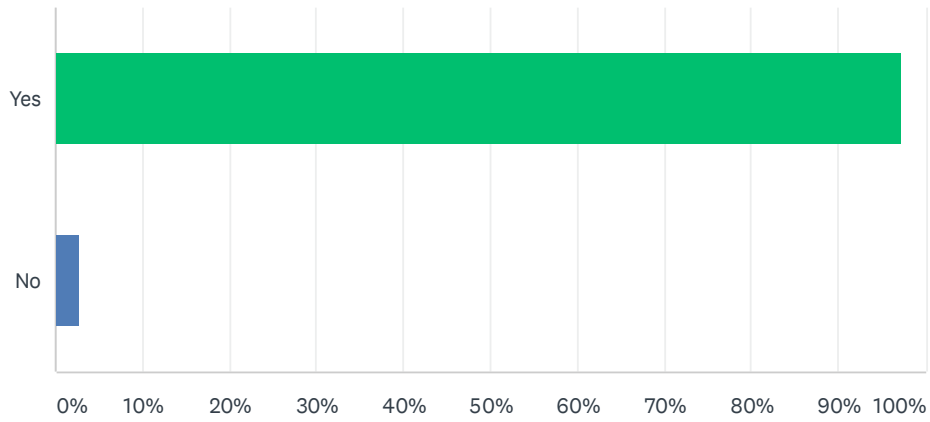


Q1 Do you live in Queen Anne's County?

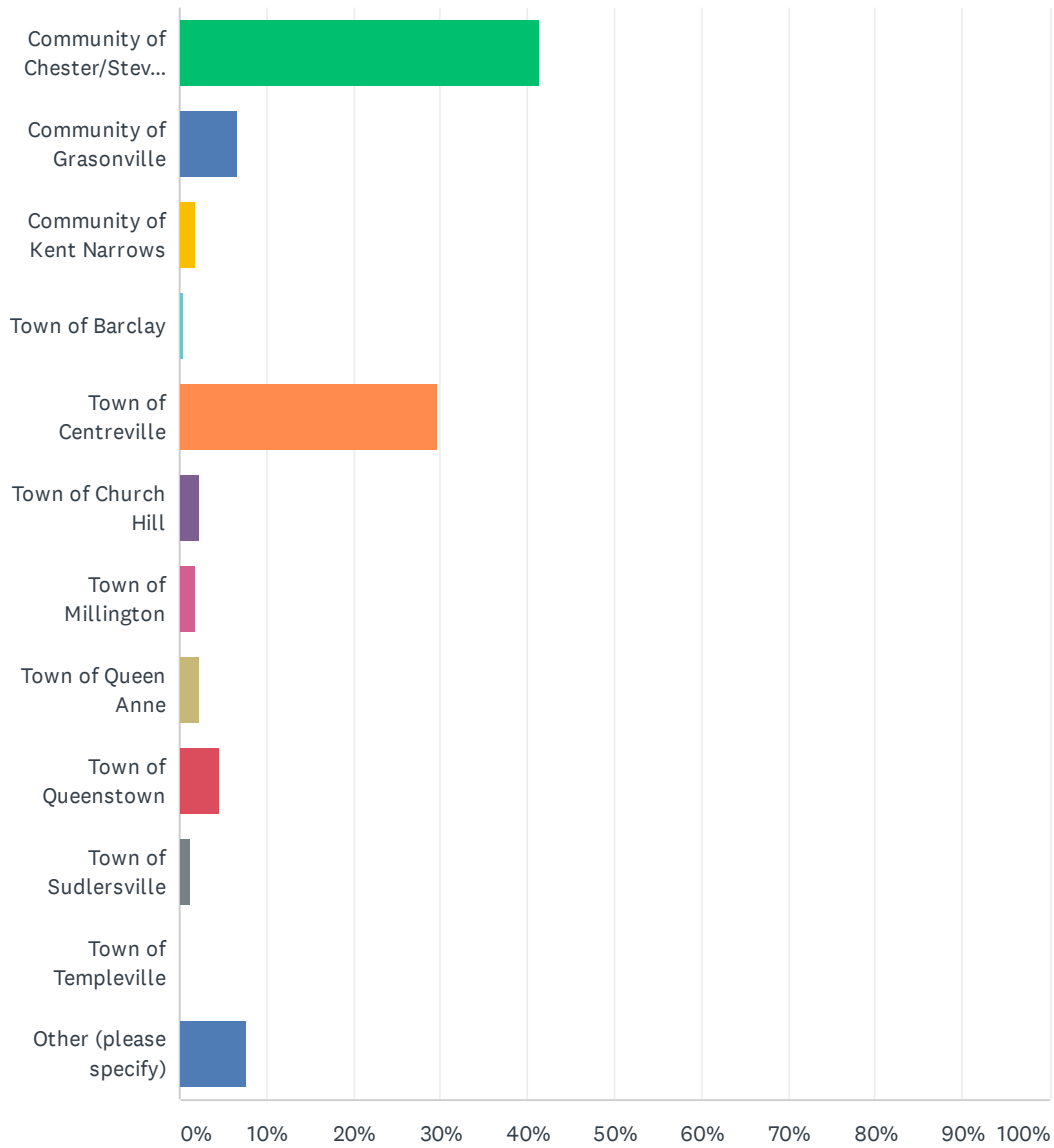

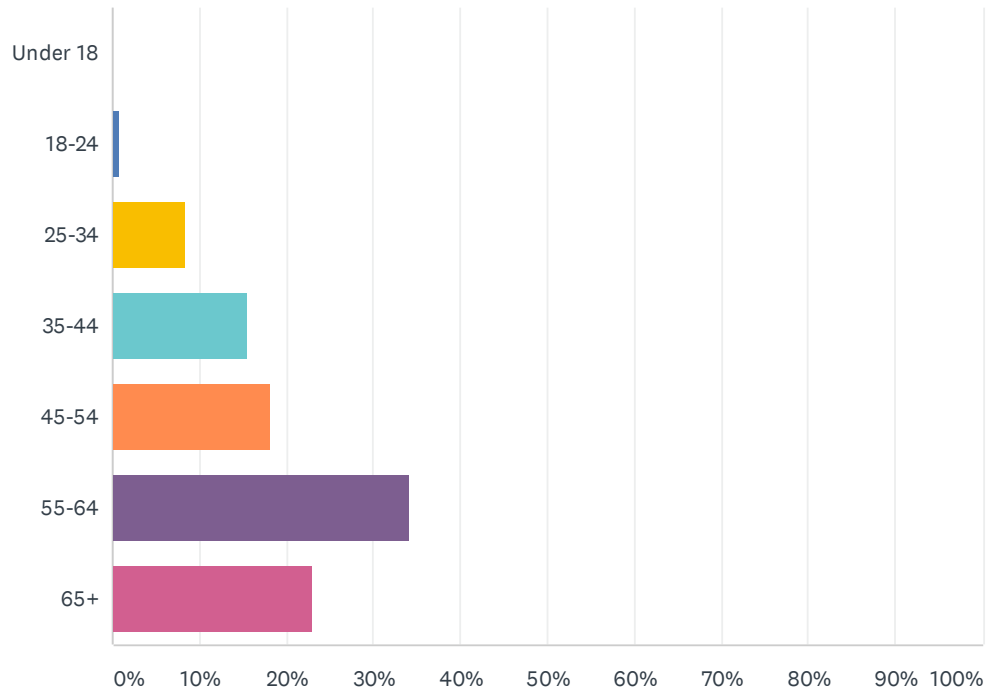

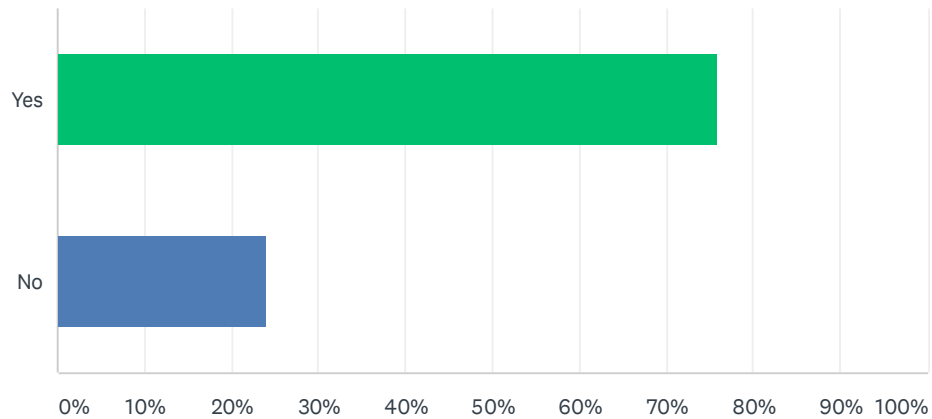
